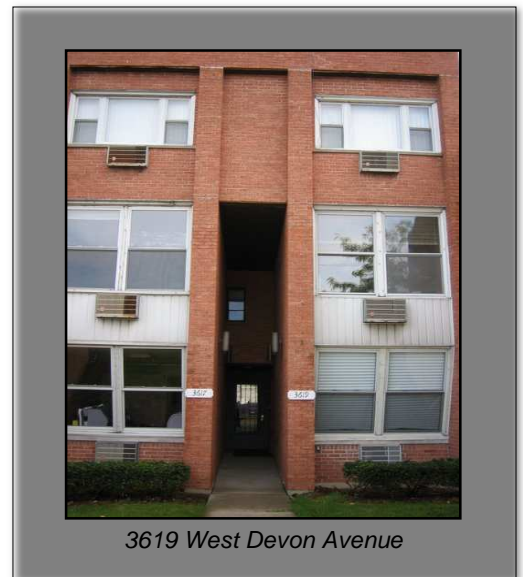

The Museum is an incredibly impressive tribute to the history of the Town of Cicero, Western Electric, and the community impact on the course of human history in the 20th Century. The impact of Western Electric

particularly in the first few decades of the 20th Century is difficult to fathom. 40,000 employees spread across a 100-acre facility that literally produced phones for the world. The plant was a city within a city.

Western Electric developed the technology that allowed motion pictures to transition from silent film to "talkies". It was there that the loudspeaker and public address system were invented. Switching technologies developed at Western Electric, which closed in the mid 1980s, were the precursors to the technology that gave rise to the Internet.
